II. Approval of Minutes:

III. Old Business:

A. Lobbyist Update

Mr. Bergman gave an update on three companies (Pointer Spruil / Franklin Group / Advantest Strategies). Mr. Turille and Mr. Bergman had concluded that the best recommendation was Pointer Spruil.

Mr. Ward, Mr. Bone, and Mr. Broadhurst all spoke in favor of Pointer Spruill because of their prior knowledge and history with all three towns.

B. Connie Wilson:

Mrs. Wilson gave an update on the past years accomplishments and then asked what the new 2016 expectations were.

C. Town Local Projects:

1. North Topsail Beach:

Mr. Turille stated that a six mile dune push is underway. They are still proceeding with inlet dredging with a projected start date of February.

2. Topsail Beach:

Mr. Bone stated that the Army Corps is reviewing data to see if the inlet sand can be used for the federal beach project.
