

## **Advocate Goals 2021**

## **State Goals:**

- 1. Continue to support state funding for the Shallow Draft Inlet Dredging Fund
- 2. Advocate for permanent funding for the Coastal Storm Damage Mitigation Fund
- 3. Facilitate legislation to allow Topsail Island towns to increase the occupancy tax
- 4. Work to increase funding and scope of coastal resilience projects for Topsail Island
- 5. Advocate to reduce the excess burden of coastal insurance plans
- 6. Modify state bidding requirements for ocean-certified dredge projects
- 7. Find assistance in obtaining funding for water and sewer projects
- 8. Work to change state funding and local financing guidelines for terminal groins
- 9. Pursue an increased share of state funding for USACE Storm Damage Reduction Projects
- 10. Request state support for the non-Federal Owners obligation under the USACE Flood Control and Coastal Emergencies Fund (PL 84-99) following storm damage
- 11. Notify TISPC of pending legislation that impacts Topsail Island

## **Federal Goals**

- 1. Continue with legislation to amend the NTB CBRA Map Unit L06
- 2. Obtain legislation to allow the continued use of sand from the New Topsail Inlet CBRA zone for non-CBRA zone beach nourishment when federal funds are involved
- 3. Work to obtain funding to keep the federal channels of Topsail Island navigable
- 4. Continue to provide assistance for the adjustment of Topsail Beach's flood maps
- 5. Advocate to promote Community Rating System discounts for flood insurance
- 6. Work to seek insights on ways to support the Federal Flood Insurance Program
- 7. Look for funding avenues for water and sewer projects
- 8. Notify TISPC of pending legislation that impacts Topsail Island

## **Other Goals**

- Work to increase understanding and cooperation between TISPC and environmental groups
- 2. Stay abreast of studies on sea level rise particularly as it relates to coastal and sound side flooding
- 3. Understand and monitor CRC regulations and proposed rule making
- 4. Be involved with efforts to find solutions for the disposal of non-federal dredge materials
